Belfield Homes is a 3-unit townhome development in North Philadelphia and will serve as a model for low-income urban infill development designed to provide zero energy homes to those least able to afford rising energy costs. These passive homes boast a projected 90% reduction in energy consumption, supported by a significant PV solar array. Each home is built in a modular factory with all foundation work being completed on site.
